Hunt for Brier Fox

Never done a Fox Hunt?

Come, and we will show you how. Most hunters will be in teams, and there will be some teams that may have room for a ride-along for anyone interested in seeing how it's done.

What You Need:

A vehicle. You will be using your vehicle to cover the search area and find the fox. And some type of VHF receiver with an S meter that will cover 146.565 Mhz FM. That is all you "need" many hunters only use the radio in the vehicle to find the fox. The Ocean Shores city WA7OS amateur repeater is available at 441.125 +5Mhz Tone 123.0Hz FM. That said, you can use any equipment you wish, directional antennas, sniffers, dopplers, or anything else. A map of the area or a laptop/smartphone with Google Earth is nice for looking at the surrounding area. Maps that show the satellite view of an area are recommended.

Hunt Area:

This hunt will be inside the city of Ocean Shores, which includes all of the land South of the city gates.
